 - Selection for travel grant would be based on the merit of the submitted abstract. Selected candidates will be intimated by email by March 1, 2016.
 - Train A/C III TIER fare would be reimbursed to the awardees on submission of proof of journey.
 - Delhi/NCR students participating in the 35th Annual Convention of IACR (IACR-2016) are not eligible for the travel grant.
